Energy to Care: Data Use Policy

Participation in the Energy to Care program is free for healthcare organizations that are ASHE members. Organizations wishing to participate in the program must first create an ENERGY STAR Portfolio Manager account. The process of creating an account involves submitting potentially sensitive data, which includes energy and water billing data, facility characteristics, and contact information. The Portfolio Manager account will then be "linked" with the Energy to Care Dashboard, powered by Lucid's BuildingOS.

The following entities will have access to the BuildingOS accounts of healthcare organizations participating in the Energy to Care program, including data contained in these accounts:

- American Society of Healthcare Engineers (ASHE) staff
- Lucid Design Group staff
- Mazzetti staff

The following are the requirements and restrictions that apply to all aforementioned entities:

- All collected individual facility data shall remain confidential and may not be distributed or shared with any other entity unless express written consent is received from the participating facility.
- Aggregate data for groups of facilities, regions, or competitions may be used for analysis and reporting of general performance as long as individual facilities and organization identifying characteristics are not shared.
- Energy to Care participant names and contact information may be shared to celebrate award winners, document local chapter participation rates, and publicize the program.
